

## Visitors Policy.

Visitors.

We have been asked to clarify the position of visitors to our events as there are important insurance considerations.

While we are very happy to encourage those who are thinking of becoming members to come along and sample what we have to offer, it is not possible for non-members to regularly attend our events, as this could invalidate the Liability Insurance provided by the Third Age Trust.

As a rule of thumb, we allow non-members to come along to one monthly meeting and one meeting of any one group. In exceptional circumstances a case may be made to the committee for an additional attendance.

Carers– an exception to the above is where a member is no longer able to continue to participate fully without the help of a carer, because for the time a carer is in attendance they will be covered by the Liability Insurance provided by the Third Age Trust. However, if the person is a professionally employed carer they must be covered by their own individual liability insurance policy.

Where a member wishes to be accompanied by a carer they must provide the Committee with the carer's details in advance.
